





~ Financial Corner ~ DANDELIONS!

I'm glad you asked. I got up early this morning and went outside to weed my rose garden. Over the past few weeks, I had noticed that the weeds were popping up. However, with all of the pollen flying around, I was not about to spend any more time outside than I had to. Well it has rained so no more excuses. After pulling up all of the weeds and replacing the pine straw around my roses, I stood back and admired my work. I even pruned a few of the bushes. As I was putting away the rake and my little spade, I looked out on the lawn. I noticed that there were a few dandelions springing up. So I spent the next 40 minutes digging them up by the root.

What in the world does dandelions have to do with finances? Perhaps you spent January and February correcting the obvious habits that may have caused your financial distress. You've done a good job. As you look over your finances, are there any "dandelions" springing up with your new habits. •

Take a look at your checkbook and see where your money is going. Sometimes we trade one bad habit for another. Is there some other area we need to tighten up on? Did I set up that emergency fund with the money I saved? Maybe we aren't shopping too much, but have we actually been living within our budget? Did we set up a budget? Did we put that extra money we saved to work for us or did we just spend it somewhere else? Clearance racks are my downfall. Now is a good time to check the racks for Christmas gifts. The stores are still trying to get rid of last years' winter gear. Also, people are bringing back Easter clothes. I found some great deals on dresses. I have nine granddaughters.

Last month I asked you to write down your plans for your income tax refund. Did you do that? Did you follow through on your plans or did you get excited and go shopping? Shopping doesn't have to be just clothes. We sometimes over spend in Lowes and Home Depot too.

As we were talking this week, McKinley mentioned he was thinking about getting a new gadget for his camera. He asked what I thought. I reminded him of his goal to finish paying off some other thing he wanted and how close he was. He decided to wait. Talking over purchases helps us stick to our goals. If you are married, make it a point to discuss your financial goals as you go along. Discuss them with your children who are old enough to understand. Ask them to help you save. Help them see the value of saving. One of them could be tasked with keeping track of how much you are saving. Every dollar saved on the light bill from the previous month could be set aside for a special treat, another day of vacation, or a special family night out. A previous co-worker asked his children to forego buying beverages when they went out to eat. For a family of five, \$2.49 per person for sodar adds up. They kept track of what they saved and used the extra money to help fund their vacation.

REPEAT NOTE: Beware of the IRS scam. I heard on the news this week that the scammers are targeting Warner Robins. If anyone calls you demanding you pay up or you are going to jail, write down the phone number, then hang up. Call the IRS using the phone number in your phone book or the police and report the incident. If they call back, let them know you have notified the police. Do not give out any banking information and don't go out and buy any money cards.



The Scholarship Ministry Visits National College Fair



The Detour members of Union Grove Missionary Baptist Church recently took a trip to the SallieMae College Answer Convention in Atlanta, Georgia. At this event, high school students were able to gather information on important college topics. They were able to gather information from colleges of their interest, learn more about the career pathways they are choosing to peruse, and speak with representatives from over 900 colleges nationwide.

- Each participant was given a barcode that the school representatives could scan after they conversed with the student. This barcode puts the student into a data table showing they were interested in the school, and that they came to talk about themselves with the representative. From there on they are able to be watched by the school because they showed interest. Informational emails and possible scholarship opportunities will be emailed to the students.
- The students said they really enjoyed the trip, and begged chaperones, First Lady Michelle Clark and Olethia Thomas, to bring them back next year. Freshmen, Jasmine Jones and Jordan Thomas, spoke very highly of their experience. Jones says "I want to major in fine arts and I spoke with the New York Film Academy representatives and I really like what they have to offer." Thomas says, "I am looking into becoming a physical therapist, and Auburn University has some really good scholarships that go towards the pre-med majors. However, Florida State was pretty convincing as well."
- UGMBC members walked away with tons of brochures, booklets, and information to think about and share with their parents when they returned home. "Now all that's left to do is keep those grades up, and pray to walk GOD's path and not stray, so we can be successful in the career we choose."
