Mothers are revolutionaries in a world of non-thinkers

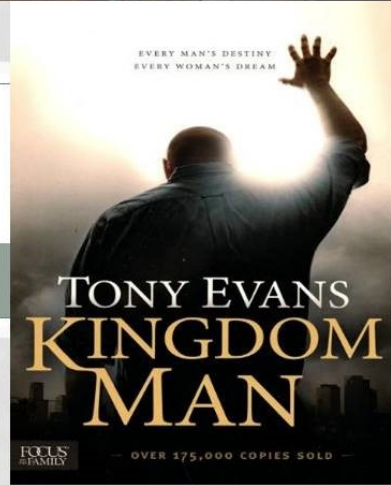

Psalm 112

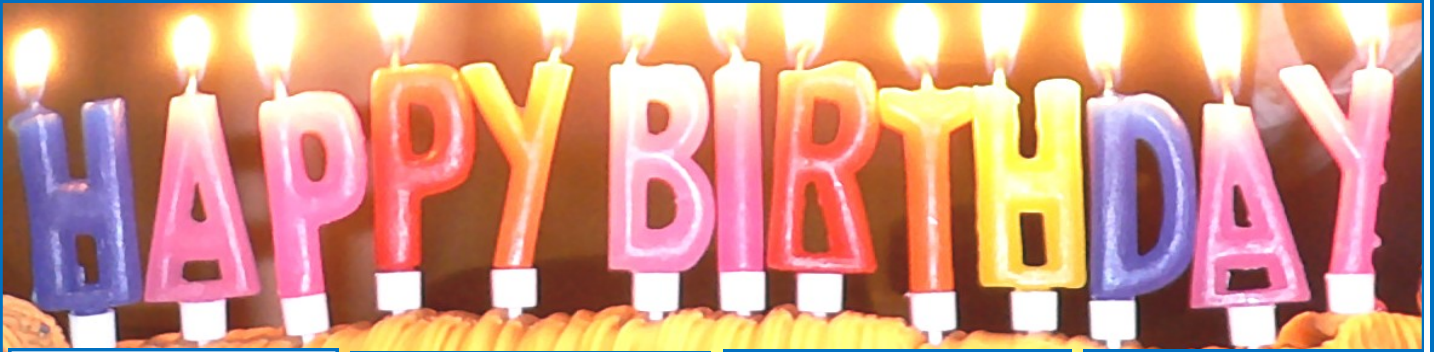

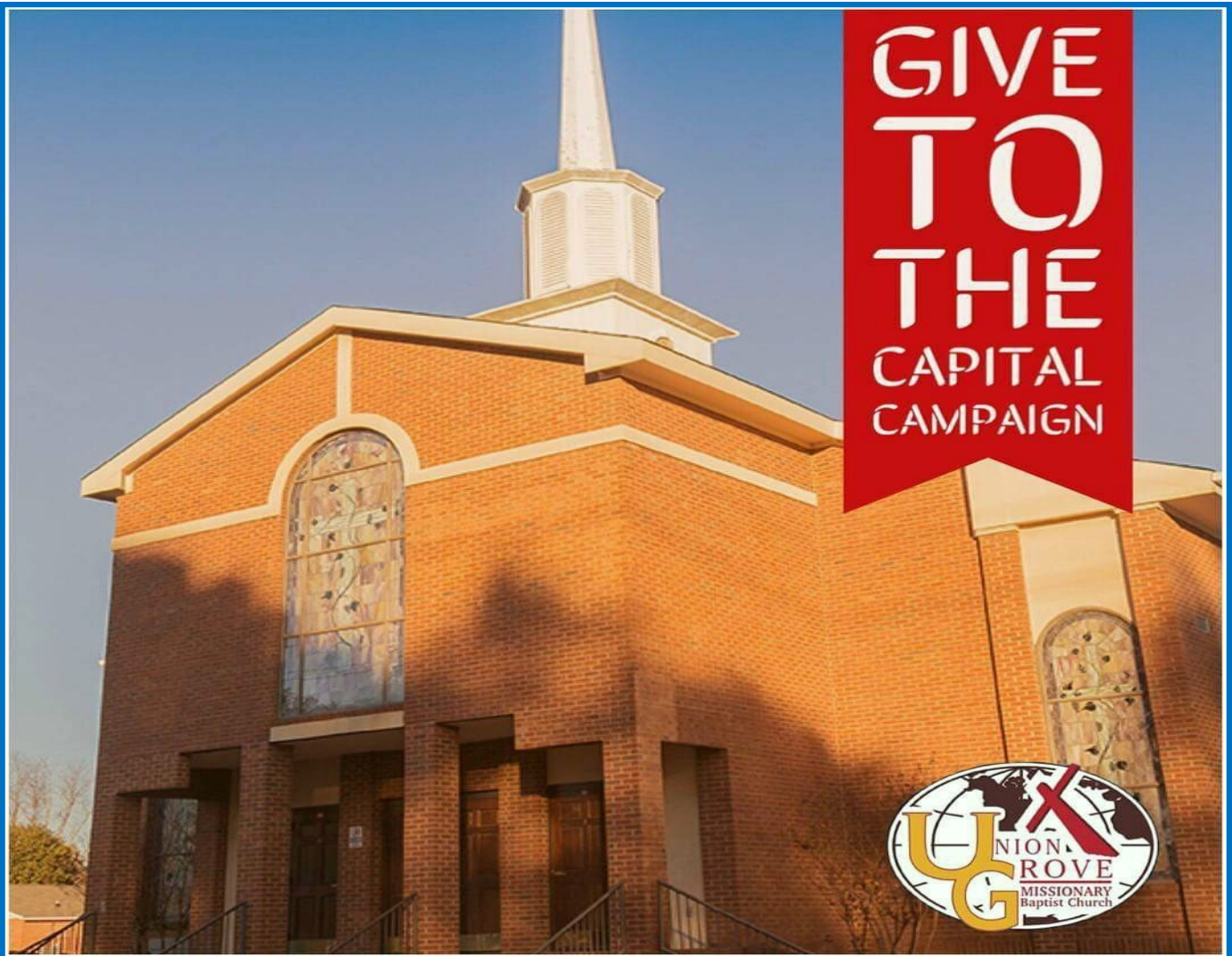


Security Ministry
