I am ambitious and wishful

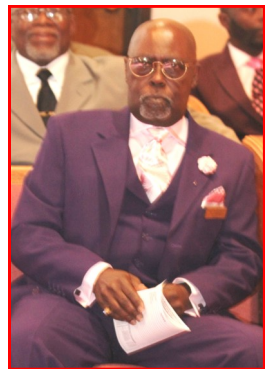

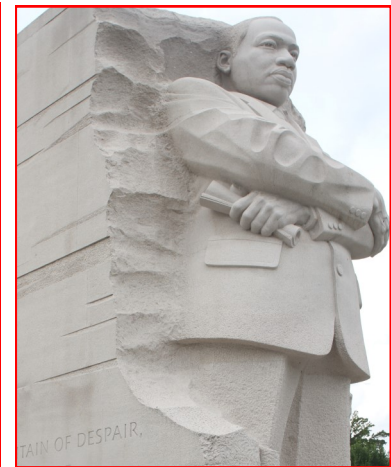


## THE OPRAH WINFREY SHOW

### July, Really?

It's July! Time for summer vacations, family reunions, and fun in the sun! Growing up, I don't remember us ever going on vacation. We would occasionally visit our grandparents or uncle for the day or overnight, but never a vacation. When I became an adult, I realized why: Too many children and too little money.

You may find yourself in this same situation. What can you do? You can start by taking short trips in your area. If you can get yourself one of the Georgia magazines, or check on line, you will see loads of fun things to do in Georgia. There are numerous fun things in this area that you can do in a day, i.e. Tubman Museum, Sandy Beach at Lake Tobesofkee (There is now a water park), White Water, Six Flags, Wild Adventures, etc. You can take a day trip or spend one night away from home. Remember, if you can't pay for it, vacationing isn't worth it. When I say pay for it, I mean no charging! Don't waste vacation money on very small children. They won't appreciate or remember it.

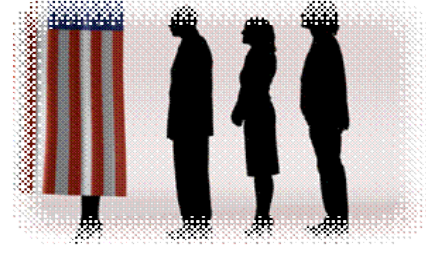

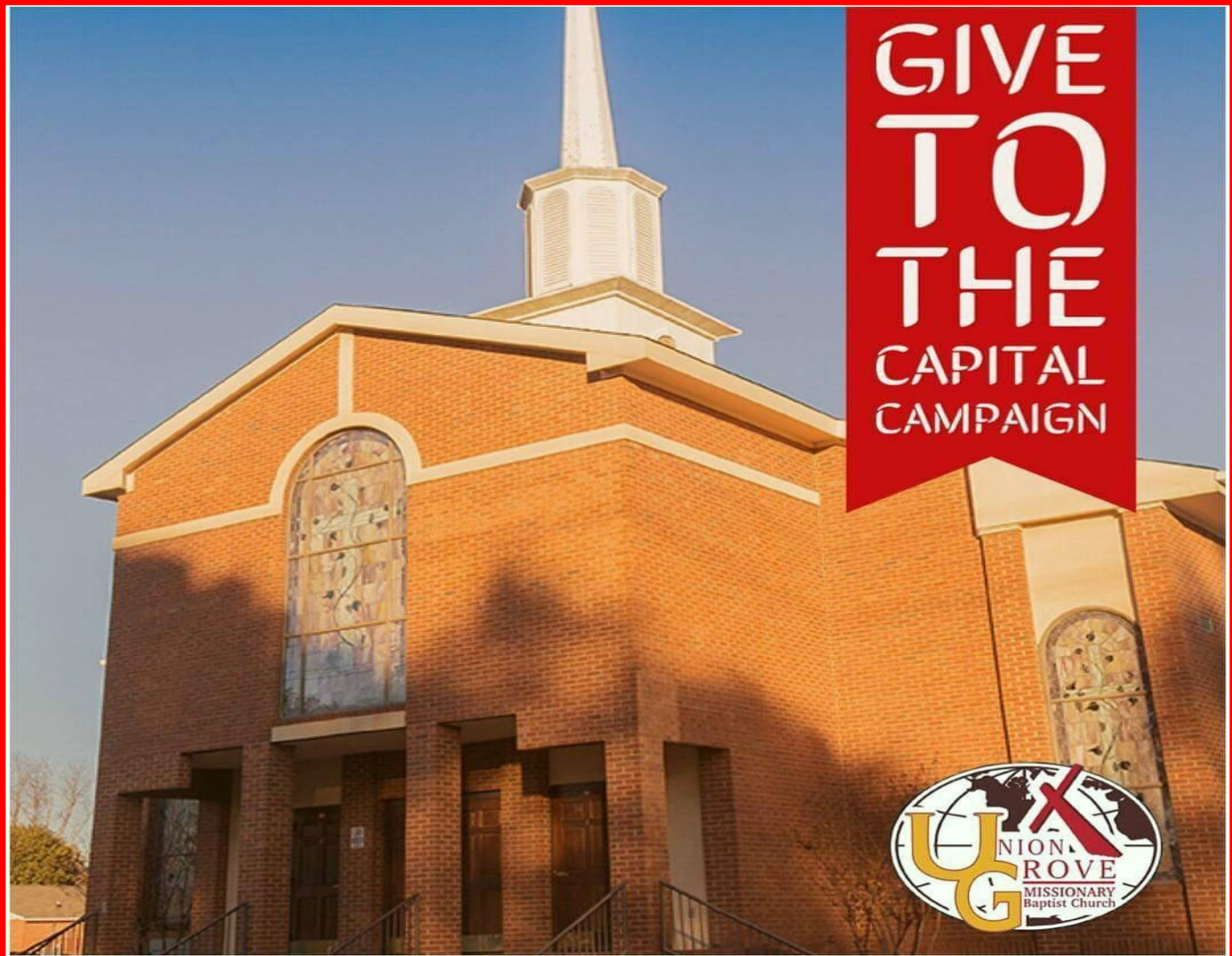
## Security Ministry
