




## ~ Men's Ministry

### WHAT IS A KINGDOM MAN?

To get an acceptable answer, all one would have to do is search the scriptures. The biblical definition of a man is one who has learned to operate under the authority of Jesus Christ while carrying out responsible and legitimate leadership within the sphere of influence that God has placed him. In Exodus 34:23-24, we read that three times a year all the males in Israel were to go on a retreat before the Lord who ruled over them. In the Old Testament, the phrase "Lord your God" means sovereign Lord. Three times a year, all of the men were to go to a certain location, and in so doing, acknowledge the sovereign rule of God in their lives. Now, before we move past that too quickly, let's look at what that might have done to those left behind.

Three times a year all of the males left their land and homes. From a military and defense perspective, that is unthinkable. From a commerce and agricultural perspective, that is unthinkable. All the men are gone and there are only women and children left to fend for themselves? That doesn't sound like a very good national strategy. But that is where the

second verse in this passage comes in. God says that while you are away seeking Me and honoring Me under My authority, men, do not worry. He says that He will see to it that no one will bother your land, houses, or anyone left behind. We read, "... no man shall covet your land when you go up . . . to appear before the Lord your God." In other words, God is saying that if you will simply align yourself under My authority, then I've got it. I'll take care of the rest. I have you covered. But in order for God to cover you, men, you are going to have to humble yourself under His authority. You are going to have to align your thoughts, actions, decisions, and leadership under the overarching viewpoint and authority of God. To be aligned under God is to consistently make your decisions, whether personal or professional, in line with God's Word. This means intentionally going to the scriptures and often to a person acquainted with the scriptures on a specific matter that you are dealing with. For example, if you are seeking to resolve a financial issue or to establish sound financial principles and stewardship in your life, you look up everything that you can find in God's Word on it and start applying it to your life. When a man follows the principles of biblical manhood, those around him benefit from his leadership and care.

The Men's Ministry has been studying a book entitled "*Kingdom Man*" by Dr. Tony Evans for the past few weeks. It challenges and equips men to fully understand their position under God as well as their position over what God has given them. It also provides concepts men can follow that will help them to actively pursue ways to maximize and develop the character qualities of biblical manhood in their lives. Please feel free to come out and join us as we take this journey together. Together we share our setbacks, all while celebrating out victories.







## ~ Financial Corner ~

### It's Not Too Late

It's not too late to start saving for retirement, your child's/your education, down payment on your new home, new car. Sometimes we just get discouraged. It's August. The year is more than half over and we haven't begun to work on our goals. We're over 40 or 50

and we don't have any retirement savings.

How do I recover or just get started? First of all, as long as we still have a goal, we can still make it. So don't give up. Starting late just means you have to work harder and smarter.

I believe each generation should raise the standard for their family, not lower it. If you find yourself living far below your families standards, alarm bells should go off to spur you to some type of action. Don't be too proud to ask for help!

Here are a few simple but doable steps to get you started:

- 1. If you are working, contact your personnel/human resources department and max out your employee contribution to your 401k/Thrift Savings/403b plan to equal your employers matching funds. This is free money. Get you some. If your employer does not have a 401k plan or does not match funds, set up an individual retirement account. You can get started with as little as \$50.
- 2. Write down every debt you have and assess the damage. What do you owe and at what interest rate. Set up a plan to pay your debts off early. If you need help setting up a plan, I am available. There may be thousands of dollars in interest savings waiting for you.
- 3. Stop charging. Credit cards are convenient, but they can get us into debt really fast. They charge compound interest (interest on interest). Try to only use your credit cards to book and pay for hotel/flight accommodations. Once you are home, pay off what you charged.
- 4. If your child is more than three years away from going to college, you can still set up an investment account to save and earn valuable tax-free interest.
- 5. If you don't have a major credit card, get one. Open a checking account somewhere. This helps your FICO score, which in turn helps to reduce your interest rates, insurance rates, etc.

NOTE: School just started a week ago. Remind your children/grandchildren that they all started with an A. It's up to them to keep them. If they need help, don't be too proud to ask.






# **Security Ministry**
