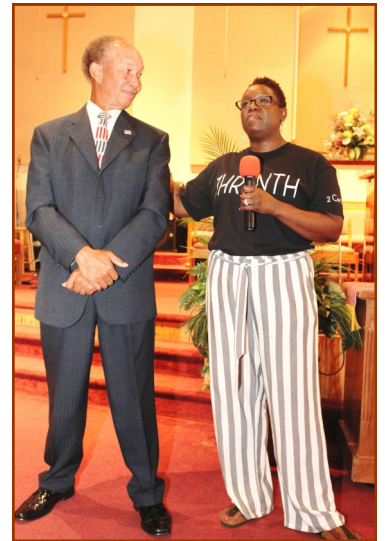

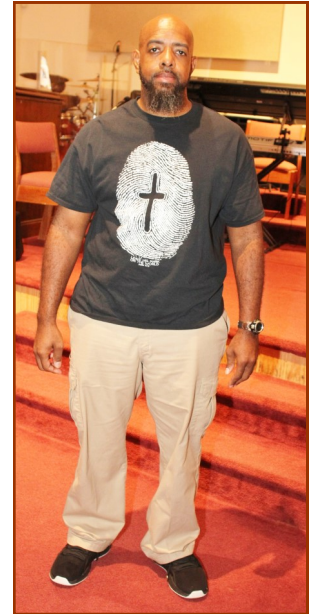

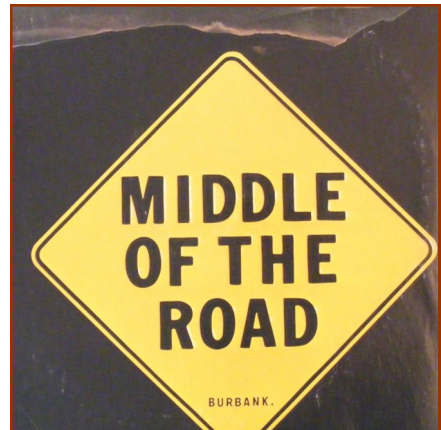
Who they are:

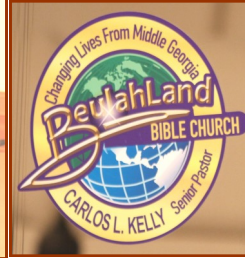

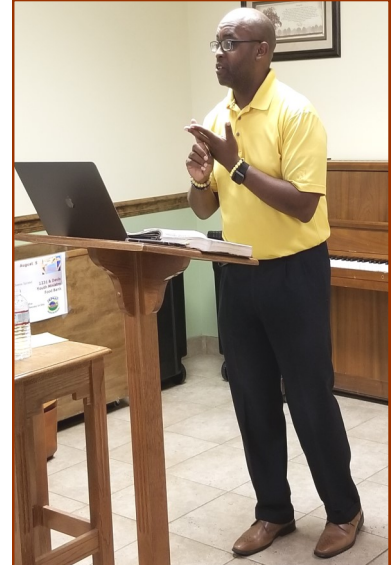

It's September already! We're nine months in. Time is moving on. What have we done with the time? Have we made good use of the first eight months of 2018? When we mess up, we apologize, we try to make amends, we may replace broken objects, torn clothing, and even wrecked cars. But time is the one thing you can't get back.

September is Life Insurance Awareness Month. It is just a reminder of the need to include life insurance in your family's financial plans. Failure to provide this protection for our families is one of the leading causes for poverty. We always mean to get some; however, time and life kept moving and before we knew it, we were old and some health issue had come up and we can no longer afford it. What will your family do if something happens to you? After burial expenses are handled, will your spouse and children be forced to change their lifestyle or struggle? If you already have some, this is the time to review it. You may need to update your beneficiary or increase/decrease the face amount.

September is the month summer clothing goes on sale at a deep discount. Stores are putting out the winter garments and don't want to pack up and store all of the summer items. Go to the clearance rack (usually in the back), take your extra percentage off coupons, and stock up on staples. These are the items that won't go out of style by next year, i.e. swimsuits, shorts, blouses, light sweaters, etc. Don't buy unnecessary items just because you can. If you can't use it or give as a gift, you are just wasting money.

If you haven't already started, now is the time to start Christmas shopping. If your children want something special or unique, now is the time to put it on lay-away or get it ordered. Don't wait until the after Thanksgiving Day sales. Specialty items will not be available. Take advantage of the next few holiday sales both in the stores and online. Count up the number of pay periods/checks you will receive between now and Christmas, determine how much of each check you can set aside for Christmas and set up your Christmas budget. This includes what you will spend on food and travel, not just presents. Once you have your budget, stick to it! This sets you up for a better more prosperous 2019.

NOTE: About a year ago, I suggested that those of you living alone without family in the area give someone you trusted a key to your home. I still recommend this. There have been a number of deceased individuals in middle Georgia found in their homes weeks too late. I further recommend you provide this trusted friend with your relatives' names and phone numbers and give your relatives their number. When the police do a well check, they don't go in the house unless they suspect foul play. Relatives can let the police know who has a key so they can check inside. You may need some medical assistance and can't notify anyone.

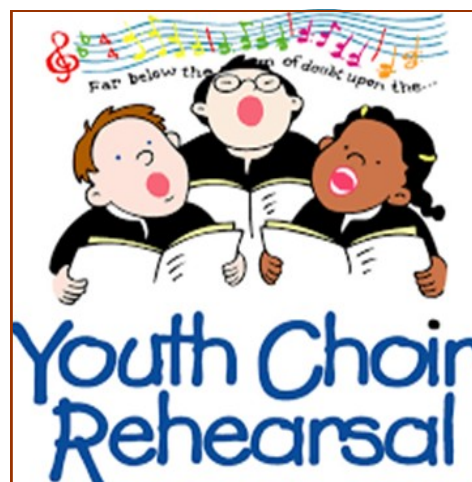

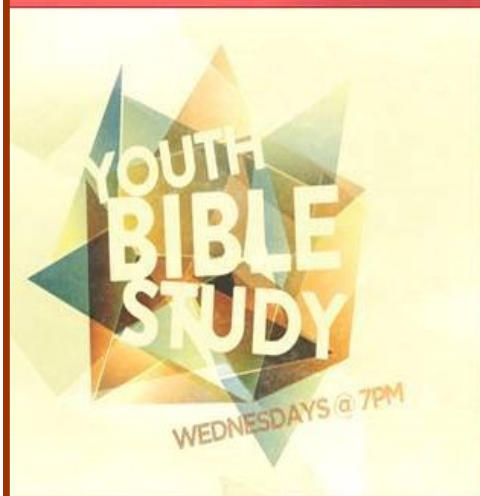

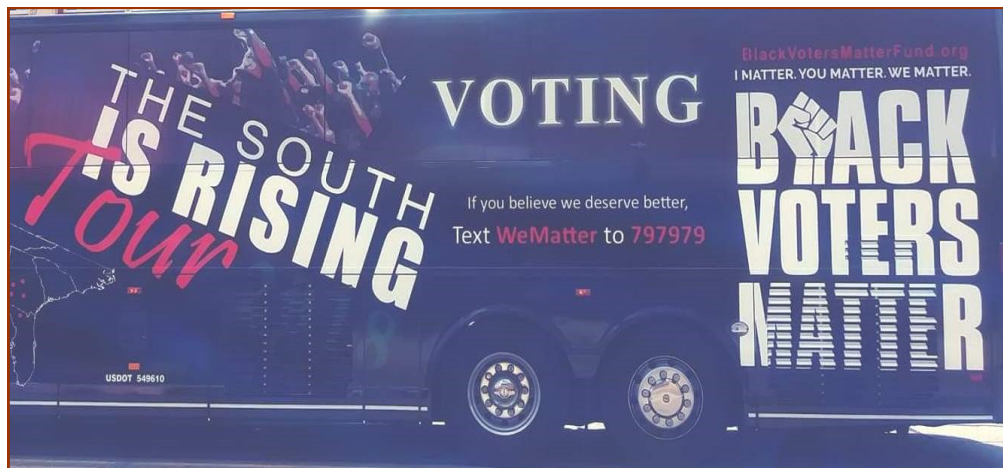
Matthew 25:26, 40 – “I was in prison and you came and visited me ... I tell you the truth in as much as you did it to one of the least, you did it for me.”

MY SOUL IS ANCHORED IN THE LORD

I'm sure many have heard the moving song by Douglas Miller, "My Soul is Anchored in the Lord". I wish to relate a few of the verses that encourage me and I hope it will encourage others to realize that our heavenly Father is our "anchor".

*"Though the storms keep on raging in my life,
and sometimes it's hard to tell my night from day".*

We who have storms in our life might feel that when they move into our lives like "waves and currents that seem so fierce. These waves and currents might be death of a love one, health problems for you as well as those you love, financial problems as well as problemist relationships. A lot of these storms we engineer by our own foolishness and disobedience. I know that we have felt so swamped and so afraid that we were going to be taken over by the storm. I, however, believe that storms come so that we will become stronger Christians and are sent by God for our growth.

As stated in Job 4:1: *"Man who is born of a woman is few of days and full of trouble."*

No matter how big of a Christian you might be, storms will come into your life. Times when you felt so swamped and so afraid that you were going to be taken over by the storm.

*"Still that hope that lies within is reassured as I keep my eyes upon the distant shore; I know

We as Christians must always keep our eyes on the distant shore. That shore might be improved health, a better job, good relationships. However, we must remember that shore is never distant if you have faith.

"But if the storms don't cease, and if the wind keeps on blowing, (in my life) my soul has been anchored in the Lord."

We know that an anchor is used to keep a ship from swaying when you might encounter heavy dangerous waves... Just as the anchor must be dropped before it reaches those strong waves we as Christian must drop our anchor early in order to be stabilized when those strong waves come into our life. Of course the anchor must be large enough to endure those waves. A large anchor for we Christians must be made of our having a strong faith that is demonstrated. It should not be just coming into the church on Sunday... We must show others our faith in and out of the church.
