What is "Passion Week"?

Passion Week, *also known as Holy Week*, begins on Palm Sunday and ends on the following Saturday. It represents the passion with which Jesus willingly went to the old rugged cross on Calvary to pay for our sins. It is filled with events of Jesus during the week prior to and including His agonizing crucifixion.

My prayer is that Union Grove will unite in corporate prayer and fasting during Passion Week to help us "Go Deeper"? We are expected to be rooted and built up in Christ, established in the faith, and abounding with gratitude (Col. 2:7). I believe corporate prayer and fasting will empower each of us to be firmly anchored in our relationship with God. Let's trust God to draw closer to us as we draw closer to Him (Jas. 4:8) through prayer and fasting during Passion Week 2019.



THERE'S STILL TIME!

Last month I talked to you about rolling your high interest credit card balances over to zero balance cards. When you do this, make sure you also roll the neuments you have been making on these cards over to the new card. Unless

payments you have been making on those cards over to the new card. Unless Sister Wanda Verrett the old card is a retail card, i.e. Belk, Penney's, etc. don't close it out. Just put

it away somewhere. Make no further charges on these cards or you will end up in even greater debt.

It's still tax time. These are my constant recommendations for those of you getting a refund.

1. Pay off debt.

Start with those credit cards. As you get these cards paid out, put them away in a safe place. No charging unless you can pay the entire balance right away Next tackle that furniture bill or signature loan.

Got any nagging hospital bills hanging out there on your credit report?

- 2. Set up your emergency fund. If you're retired, a minimum of \$1,000 is sufficient. One thousand dollars will cover most auto and appliance breakdowns. For those of you still working, you need to cover your salary for at least six months in case you are laid off or become disabled.
- 3. Make necessary repairs on your home/car
- 4. Start your Individual Retirement Account (IRA)
- 5. **Start that education fund for your children**. You know the one you intended to set up right after they were born.
- 6. Set money aside for Christmas 2019. You can do this with a short-term investment account.

For those of you not yet tithing (Giving 10% of gross income) and have made resolutions or commitments to start this year, it is not too late. In the Married Couples Sunday School class, we are studying "The Marriage Challenge" by Art Rainer. It is a finance guide for married couples. There is a recommendation in this book that I think will help you get going. You can start slowly and build up to it over the rest of the year:

March give 1% of gross income	April - June Give 3%
July – Sep Give 5%	Oct and Nov Give 7%

Dec – You made it. Give 10% of gross income. Keep up the good work from here on.

Watch those blessings roll in!

For those of you already tithing, thank God for the opportunity and the means to tithe and give an offering.










Security Ministry




