

What do you do? Put more water in it, right? Right! So you just finished mopping the bathroom and kitchen floors and decide to take the used, filthy water from

that mop bucket and put some in the pot of greens. Eeewwwwwww. Yuuuuuuuuck! The pot of greens is ruined! The great ingredients are now null and void because of the nasty, filthy water from the mop bucket. Who would want to eat those greens now? No one!

Union Grove is an awesome congregation because of its wonderful ingredients. The Lord is with us. That's the best ingredient of all! Then, there are some loving, kind, generous, wise, caring, anointed, patient, and hospitable people who are the best people you could ever know. There are people in the Grove Zone committed to learning, serving, giving, and connecting and they do their part to make our ministry do what it do with excellence. 
Afterwards, the youth traveled to Pizza Hut and had a fun-filled fellowship to celebrate our 2019 High School Seniors.






