




#### Craft Activity: Book Mark and Reading Exchange #1






#### **Hope You Enjoyed Your Fourth!**

Last month Mack and I attended Primerica's International Convention in Atlanta. I learned a lot and was reminded of why I joined in the first place. Of the many great speeches, one stood out in my mind. During the African American Leadership Workshop, one of the speakers told us that by 2053, it is predicted that the net worth of African Americans will be zero. That's right ZERO. I wondered how can this be. We're making more money. We're out of the cotton and peach fields. We're going to college in record numbers. The truth is, we're spending not just what we're making, but more than we make. We don't own enough property, stocks, or anything to pass on to the next generation. Proverbs 13:22 says, "A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children; and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just."




