Faith That Pleases God

Heb. 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

*Faith That Pleases God* is our new sermon series we launched for 2020. If we're going to seriously follow Jesus, we need faith that pleases God. Here's a recap from the first sermon of the series preached on Sunday, January 5, 2020.

When you have faith that pleases God:

### 1. You work toward what God expects. (v.1)

<sup>1</sup>Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

### 2. You can see what God said. (v.3)

<sup>3</sup> By faith we understand that the entire universe was formed at God's command, that what we now see did not come from anything that can be seen.

### 3. You seek God because you want to please God. (v.6)

<sup>6</sup> But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

### 3a. Seek God because it is required

"...without faith it is impossible to please Him..."

### 3b. Seek God because He is real

"...must believe He is..."

### 3c. Seek God because He rewards

"...He is a rewarder..."

### 3d. Seek God relentlessly

"...diligently seek Him"

### 4. You and God can handle anything! (v.33-40)

# **HAPPY NEW YEAR!**

It's 2020! Thank God we made it! What will I do differently this year? Forget about resolutions. Let's just take some concrete steps to make 2020 a more prosperous year.

- a. First, let's look at last year and see what financial decisions got us closer to our goals and which ones didn't. Repeat the ones that did and forget the ones that didn't.
- b. Still looking back at last year, how much did I save? Was it enough to cover any emergencies that came along? Was it enough to cover the vacations we went on? Was it enough to cover Christmas 2019 without charging? If not, make a little adjustment. Hopefully, you didn't go over too much.
- c. Go to Personnel or your Human Resources person, or your supervisor to make adjustments in your withholding for federal and state. If you got a large refund in 2019, you definitely need to change your withholding. The average refund is \$3,129.00. Divide that by 12 months and you could have had an extra \$260.00 per month in your pocket to pay down debt, save for Christmas, college funds, or more importantly your retirement.
- d. Start getting your records together for tax season. It will be on us in no time. Also, it is not too late to contribute to your 2019 retirement fund.
- e. Let's take a look at our credit card statements. Check out the interest rates on each one. If one is really high, and you are disciplined enough, consider rolling that high interest balance to one of your cards with a lower balance (check balance transfer fees) or one with zero interest. Put both cards away and don't charge on them until the balance transfer has been paid out.
- f. When you get your cards paid out, don't close the account. Simply put the card away or charge only enough each year to keep them active and not paying any or low annual fees.
- g. Start your 2020 Christmas shopping now. The after Christmas sales are still going on and you can pick up some great bargains. In addition to getting some great things for myself, I've already put away several gifts for others on my list. When you have as many grandchildren as we do, you have to pace yourself.
- h. Many of the financial experts on TV give the same advice as I do: Get out of debt and save more. What does that look like? If you have to charge, stay out of the store. Leave your credit cards at home to avoid temptation. We'll talk about saving next month.






