UNIT 3 OF THE WINTER RECAP

I Cor. 12:1, 28 – Now concerning spiritual gifts ...And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers ...

Greeting to everyone; we have recently wrapped up the Unit Three of Winter Quarter of our Sunday School lessons from the Gospel of John. As we continue in the Gospel of John, I trust that you are being blessed and are enjoying the journey. God is constantly at work in the lives of His people as He transforms us to be the people He has called us to be. We have a vaccine for this COVID-19 virus yet over 510,000 lives are lost in these United States. Continue to trust God for a cure and, just remember God is still in control. The theme for the quarter is: Preparation of Jesus Disciples. We have discussed Unit I titled **Getting Started**; Unit II titled **Getting to Know Jesus**; and have now completed Unit III **Going deeper with Jesus**.

UNIT III: GOING DEEPER WITH JESUS:

What does it mean to go deeper with Jesus? Going deeper with Jesus means getting a better understanding of who Jesus is, and following and paying closer attention to His teachings. Going deeper allows us to increase our spiritual growth and develop the mind of Christ. Becoming more like Him in what we say and do.

In **Lesson 1, Jesus' the Light of the World**: This lesson is one where Jesus makes another startling claim. Because Jesus of Spiritual things the carnal minded Jews had difficulty understanding. They were quick to dismiss as a quack. Little did they realize they were in the presence of the Messiah. It reminds me of the scripture in Hebrews that states we entertain angels without knowing. The earlier verses in Chapter 8 addresses the problem of sin. A woman caught in adultery was to be stoned. Jesus was asked what he thought? His response was "He who is without sin, cast the first stone". Nothing happened and Jesus sent the woman away. Jesus continued to teach and made the statement "I am the Light of the World." Again, they refuse to accept Jesus and made the statement you are speaking only for yourself. When we reject Jesus, we are walking in darkness(sin). We have been compelled to turn from the darkness and walk in the marvelous light of Jesus. Jesus as Jesus is our source of life, we too have a light. We must let our light shine to be that beacon for others. We have been told in **Matthew 5:16** to let our light shine before others that our good deeds might be seen and God gets the glory. Many people are afraid of the dark because their view is obstructed. When we put our trust in Jesus, even if we can't see, Jesus sees for us. He is the source of Life everlasting.

In **Lesson 2, Jesus' Claim to Deity**: In this lesson we have Jesus making the argument that He is God. His use of the name I Am is evident of that because that is what God told Moses to tell the people and Pharaoh. The Jewish leaders were very angry and upset with this claim and was ready to stone Jesus to death. Jesus was accused of being demon possessed and being a Samaritan. They went as far as calling Jesus a liar. Because they were unwilling to accept what Jesus was saying and had no way of disproving it, they resorted to making up stuff and lying. They made claims of Abraham being their father and Jesus countered if Abraham was really your father you would know who I am. When Jesus promised them eternal life if they keep His saying they called Him crazy. They thought Jesus was seeking glory and honor for Himself. Everything Jesus did was to bring Glory and Honor to God. They were unable to accept Jesus' claim because of the hardening of their hearts. This lesson points out **1**. If you truly know God, you will know His son. **2**. If we know God we will rejoice and obey His Son. **3**. Jesus was God in the flesh, walking among mortal man. **4**. Jesus is the second person of the Trinity. Father, **Son**, Holy Spirit.

In **Lesson 3, Jesus' Response to a Dire Need**; gives us an account of what happened prior to Jesus raising Lazarus. Lazarus become sick and his sisters sends a message informing Jesus that the one He loves is ill. Jesus' reactions are not what you would expect from someone you love but Jesus is acutely aware of the circumstances. Nothing ever

catches Jesus by surprise. He tells them this sickness will not bring about the death of Lazarus. So Jesus delays in going. After 2 days Jesus tells His disciples, Let's get ready to go to Judea to wake up Lazarus for he is sleeping. Sleeping is a metaphor for death. The disciples does not know this. They recall the people in Judea want to kill Jesus and it would be suicide to go there now. Jesus inform them he has work to do. The disciples argue if he's only sleeping he'll wake up. He's probably need the rest. Jesus makes it plain to them that Lazarus is dead and He must go thee to awake him. This is the last of the seven signs of the Messiah that John describes in his Gospel. Jesus makes this shocking statement "I'm glad for your sake that I wasn't there. Now you and others will have the opportunity to see and believe that I Am the Son of God. From seeing and believing, God will get the Glory. Points from this lesson is **1.** Know who to call when trouble arise. **2.** Jesus loves for us is unconditional (agape love). **3.** Jesus does not operate on our timetable. We can't hurry Him no matter how desperate we are.

In **Lesson 4, Assurance of Victory over Death;** The account of Lazarus' death is a sign of hope for all who believes and live for Jesus. Lazarus had been in the grave for four (4) days and the people were mourning and consoling Mary and Martha. When Martha heard Jesus was there, she went to meet Him. She said to Jesus, "If you had been here my brother would not have died." Jesus had a purpose for not being there. That's why He delayed. His purpose was to give His disciples proof without any doubt as to who He was. Lazarus death was for the benefit of others to have faith and keep the faith. Not only the 12 but his other followers and believers. Martha concluded I know whatever you ask of God, God will give. That's a statement and sign of true faith in Jesus. Jesus told Martha, "Your brother will rise again." Martha was thinking of the resurrection of the dead in the last days. However, Jesus was speaking in the present. Martha goes and gets Mary and the mourners follow. When Mary sees Jesus she falls at His feet and say the same thing Martha said earlier. "If you had been here my brother would not have died." Jesus is Omnipresent which means he is anywhere and everywhere. We must come to the realization that Jesus is just a prayer away. Lazarus death, while being a sadden experience for his family had a spiritual and teaching purpose. Lazarus death allows the opportunity for others to get a deeper knowledge and understanding of Jesus. **1.** Even in Jesus' delay, He is on time. **2.** We must stay connected to Christ and believe in him. **3.** We can be assured that Jesus cares for us. **4.** Pain and suffering will come, but Jesus is always there to comfort us. **5.** We serve a Savior who is compassionate.

Finally, in **Lesson 5, A Display of Divine Glory;** The moment has come for the seventh and final sign of the Messiah that is addressed in the Gospel of John. Earlier, Jesus told Martha that he is the Resurrection and the Life she was thinking of the End of Days. When Mary came to Jesus with the same statement, Jesus was moved. He saw and felt the pain and sorrow of the people for Lazarus. He sees our pain and suffering and wants to relieve it. Pain and suffering are the cross we too must bear. Jesus wept along with the people for He truly loves us and have compassion for us. Even though Lazarus has been in the tomb four days, Jesus have them remove the stone. He prays to God, the Father. Jesus does nothing without the consent of the Father. Yes, He was God on earth and had been given authority, yet he still relies on God the father. We must submit out entire being to God in all we do. For without God, we accomplish nothing. After He prays, he calls Lazarus from the grave. This symbolizes deliverance from the bondage of death. Yes, this mortal body will one day decay, but in Christ we have life everlasting. **2 Corinthians 5:8 states** "To be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord." **1.** Life and death is in the Hands of the Lord. **2.** As we stay connected to Christ and believe in him, we will never die. **3.** We are assured and promised a Resurrected life. **4.** In our pain and suffering, Jesus is always there to comfort us. **5.** Jesus promise to be with us in the worst and best of times.

During this unit we have learned what it means to Go Deeper with Jesus. It good to have knowledge of Jesus, it's even better to know Jesus. In the 3.5 years that Jesus ministered on earth, He trained and prepared His disciples to carry on His work. Being a disciple of Christ is a process of the will. **1.** Are you willing to give up your choice and human desires to be a follower of Christ? **2.** Are you will to be talked about, criticized and cast aside for Christ? **3.** Are you willing to share the Good news with others? Wide is the gate and easy is he road that leads to destruction, but narrow is the gate to life and the path we trod is hard. We have to **Press Toward the Mark to the Higher Calling.**

May God continue to bless this ministry as we strive to share the Good News of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior?
