What are/were the "Roaring Twenties"? The Roaring Twenties refers to the decade of the 1920s in Western society and Western culture. It was a period of economic prosperity with a distinctive cultural edge in the United States and Europe, particularly in major cities such as Berlin, Chicago, London, Los Angeles, New York City, Paris, and Sydney. (Wikipedia) After the 1919 Flu pandemic, the U.S. economy came roaring back. Everyone was excited to be out and about without face coverings. People went shopping, traveling, spending, spending, spending. Sound familiar?

Well, it has been said we are in the midst of another "Roaring Twenties". It's 2021, we are coming out of another pandemic, and people are anxious to shed the mask, get out, and are spending money. What has that to do with you? In the 1920s, the stock market shot up like a rocket. It has already begun to go up and is predicted to continue for a while. If you are not already in the market, now would be a good time to invest. *Proverbs 21:5 The plans of the diligent lead to profit as surely as haste leads to poverty.* 

I must tell you that all investments are subject to some type of risks. If anyone tells you there is no risk in investing, run and take your money with you. I still think investing is a great idea. You must, however, consider your investment goals (What is the purpose of the money I hope to make), how much liquidity do I need (Can I quickly turn this investment into cash?), what is my risk tolerance (Can I let these funds stay put even if there is a short downturn in the market), Am I sheltered from inflation risks (If the inflation rate is 3%, am I getting a return of at least that to stay even). Consider this. If you leave your money in a savings account at the bank/credit union getting a return of .7% and the inflation rate is 4.2% (current US inflation rate), you have lost 3.5% spending power. In other words, your money is worth 3.5% less that when you put it into the bank.

We all need three types of savings, emergency funds, short term, and long term. Look around and make sure you make the most of the money God has given you.

**SCAM ALERT:** I received a call from someone claiming to be calling from AT&T Direct TV. The person stated that they were about to lower my bill by \$50. The person transferred me to another person who restated that they would reduce my DIRECTTV bill by \$50, but that I had to pay the first six months in advance. Thereafter, my bill would reflect the reduction for another 18 months. All I had to do was use an EBAY gift card. As I didn't have one, he proceeded to tell me what stores were close to me so I could purchase one.

#### Union Grove Healthcare Updates for May, June 2021



Union Grove Healthcare Ministry is still alive. We want to thank God for all the participants that came out on Tuesday, May  $25^{th}$  from 3 PM - 6 PM to get their COVID-19 vaccine. This was the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine that prevents you from getting the COVID-19 virus. This vaccine is administered as two dose series, three weeks apart into muscles. It is approved for ages 12 and older. You will be given a CDC vaccination card after receiving your first dose with date and location where to get your second dose.

Union Grove Healthcare will sponsor this walk- in clinic again on June 15<sup>th</sup> from 3 PM - 6 PM for first and second dose clients. If this is your first dose you will be getting your second dose at Houston Medical Center with day and time. We would like to thank God and Pastor David Clarke for allowing us to have this event at our church to support our congregation, our community, our Middle and High Schools plus anyone else that is in need of getting their vaccination. If you know of anyone that is homebound or sick that hasn't received their shots please let the Healthcare Ministry know by giving them a name and phone number. Someone will be in touch with them to get their vaccinations to them.

We give special thanks to the Union Grove Administrative Staff and Union Grove volunteers for helping us with this event. We thank DPH and Houston Medical Center for administering the shots. We also thank Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Anderson for the special treat, Wendy's Frosties. They were delicious and cooling, it was hot, (93 degrees), we enjoyed them. We thank Minister Earnestine Thompson and Minister Annie Lester for putting this event together.

Remember to bring your vaccination card when you come to get your second dose to show the type of vaccination you received. This will ensure you get the same vaccine when you return for your last shot because they cannot be mixed. No one can be charged for vaccine doses, it's free. Let everyone you know, we will have another event on June 15th for anyone needing a shot. Houston County and State of Georgia is still in low 30% of being vaccinated so please help us to help someone else to protect themselves and others. Please remember to follow CDC guidelines and procedures.


