~ Message From The Pastor ~

Cancel culture is a movement that attempts to cancel, dismantle the influence of, ruin the career of anyone who demonstrates "bad" behavior. Cancel culture strives to remove behavior deemed toxic such as, sexual harassment, racism, homophobia, and sexism from our society. This is pushed, oftentimes, with no willingness for discourse with accused offenders. A few celebrities who have been the target of cancel culture include:

- J.K. Rowling for remarks made regarding gender
- Dr. Seuss for insensitive & racial depictions of Black and Asian characters
- Kevin Hart who was fired from hosting the Oscars over old homophobic tweets
- DaBaby who offended LGBTQ+ during a live show
- Dave Chappelle for remarks in his Netflix show, *The Closer*

Jesus is our radical revolutionary Christ who came to cancel bad behavior such as sin, hypocrisy, self-righteousness, empty and vain worship, and all the works of the devil (1 Jn. 3:8b). And we, Christ's Church, are called to cancel. This is our focus for 2022—Called to Cancel. 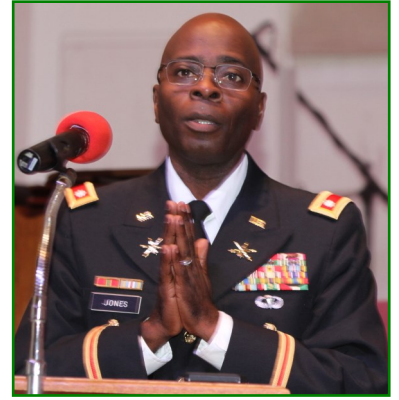

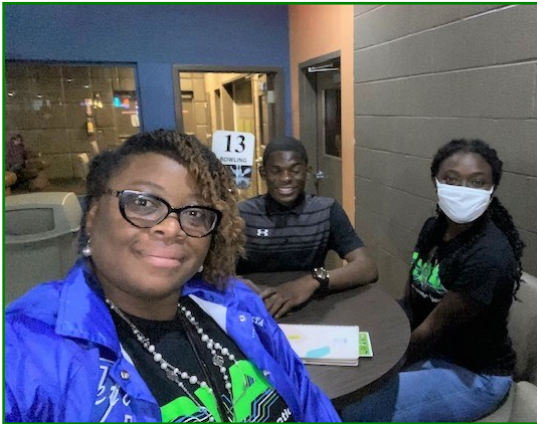

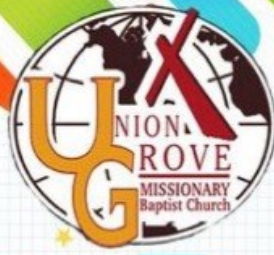

It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas. December 25th is coming fast. Are you ready? If you're like me, the pandemic has wreaked havoc with my shopping. I had to play catch up online to get it done. Only one present to buy.

Don't be stressed out because you do not have the money you had hoped for this year. The gift of time is more important than any store-bought trinket you can imagine. God sent his son, the greatest gift, to be the salvation for the world. We cannot beat that gift.

Because of COVID-19, there are bargains everywhere. I shop mostly online these days and I look for coupon codes to help bring prices down. Once you buy something online, stores will continue to send you info on upcoming sales, discounts, and coupons for later use. Just like in the store, don't be too proud to use the coupon. Search for coupon codes for online and in-person shopping. You can search for the codes while you are in line or even at the register.

Clearance racks have the best bargains. They are marked down already and sometimes stores offer an additional discount that even applies to clearance (Read the fine print on the coupon). When I picked up an online order from Belk, the clerk gave me a coupon to come into the store to see additional markdowns.

Be careful of the fraud websites out there. Someone is always trying to get your money. Be leery of websites you haven't used before. I won't call them all crooks. FALL RECAP FOR NOVEMBER

I Cor. 12:1, 28 – Now concerning spiritual gifts ...And God have set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers ...

As the Fall weather arrives and we get to see the changes in our environment, we continue to praise God for all the blessings and favors He continues to do in our lives. Likewise, it is a pleasure to monthly bring you the recap of each unit lesson. We give thanks to God for keeping us safe and allowing us to gather in this building again. He continues to do marvelous things and we are looking forward to Greater Things Happening. For the month of November Brother Michael White and Dr. Ernest Jones facilitated the lessons. We are still examining the internal working of God in the lives of His chosen vessels using as a theme: **Faith on Trial**. Unit 1 was titled **Learning God's Holiness**; and Unit 2 was titled, **Seeing God's Faithfulness** and as we wrap up Unit 2, we concluded the month with Unit 3 **Taking God Seriously**.

Unit 3: Taking God Seriously:

This last unit shows the importance of taking God seriously at all times. God holds us accountable for the things we say and do. Whenever we go against the commands of God and His spokesperson, we are in grave danger. When we rebel, we can be sure of judgment. We must consider our actions as well as the actions of others. We must not be too quick to follow the crowd. Taking God Seriously requires us to faithfully follow Him, trust, and keep His commands.

Lesson 1: Rebellion of the People was highlighted in last month's GTAH article

Lesson 2: Moses' Prayer and God's Answer: (After the people had rebelled against God, the Glory of the Lord appeared before all the people at the tabernacle and God spoke to Moses and said I will disown this people and destroy them with a plague. God was angry and Moses interceded for the people. Moses made a request to God. Pardon these people for if you destroy them what will the other nations and the Egyptians think. You were not able to do what you said so you killed them in the Wilderness. Moses pleaded with God, you are longsuffering and merciful. God relented and listened to Moses. Yet, all these people still tempt me and have not listened to me, they will not enter the land I promised. God identified Caleb as His servant because he was willing to speak up for God, Caleb was exempted from the judgment. (1.) We can all call on God and He will listen to our prayers. He might not respond. The prayers of the righteous avail much. (2.) God's patience with us will run out, but He will listen to the sincere prayer of others and relent on His judgment. His mercy is everlasting. We may still face the consequences of our actions. (3.) It's a good thing to have someone stand in the gap for us as Moses did. Even when God forgives us for our sins, we must not take God for granted. When we take a stand for God, God will greatly reward us. We must Take God Seriously

Lesson 3: Korah's Rebellion: The Golden text – “We should love the Lord and keep His charge, His statutes, His judgments, and His commandments, Always.” (Deuteronomy 11:1). This lesson continues with more rebellion. This time it is a man named Korah, a Levite. He conspired with two other men to incite a rebellion against Moses. These three men had the masses of a following of 250 prominent members of the community. They felt they had as much right as Moses and that all of Israel was set apart by God. They told Moses and Aaron they had gone too far. You are no greater than the rest of us. Moses told Korah, God will show who He has selected and who is not.

You and your followers get your incense burners ready for tomorrow. Light them and burn them before the Lord and see whom the Lord has chosen as His Holy one. Moses added, You Levites are the ones who have gone too far. Korah was not satisfied with what God had chosen for him. He wanted more. He wanted Aaron priestly position. It is not me and Aaron you are revolting against. You are revolting against God. Dathan and Abiram were also summoned but they refused to come. They accused Moses of bringing them out of Egypt to kill them in the wilderness. You haven't proven anything. You are trying to fool us. (1.): Envy can destroy the body of Christ. (2.): Rebellion may rise up from members in prominent positions. (3.): People may see what God is doing and refuse to believe and accept it as God work. (4.): God will show Himself faithful to his people. (5.): When you have been wrongly accused, take it to God. (6.): God is not trying to meet our expectation or demands. He wants us to meet His expectations. Take God Seriously

Lesson 4: Judgment on the Rebellion: God warns Moses about what he must do. Korah had stirred up the people and they were against Moses. The glory of the Lord appeared and tells Moses and Aaron to get away from these people so He can destroy them right now. God does not want innocent people to be destroyed. God is justified in what He does. Again, Moses intercedes. He asked God not to be angry with all the people because of Korah. God told Moses to tell the people to get away from Korah, Nathan, and Abiram tent. Don't touch anything. The community watched as the ground opened up and swallowed the entire families of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram. The people scattered out of fear that the same might happen to them. These people were spared because of Moses' intervention. God is a righteous judge. Fire blazed from the Lord and killed the 250 men who followed Korah and had offered incense. You will be held accountable for your actions. (1.) Jealousy and betrayal can destroy the body of Christ. (2.) We will suffer the same fate of sinners if we go along with their schemes. (3.) God will always keep His word to you. (4.) Have a fear of the Lord for His awesomeness and power. Take God Seriously

Lesson 5: Water from a Rock: God is still faithful to a people that is faithless. This statement should remind us that God can be trusted to provide for us even in our faithlessness. We do not take God as serious as we should. We expect God to bless us regardless. That is taking God for granted. Brother White read Psalm 95 to remind us to worship God and to not harden our hearts. Don't do what others may do but examine your own heart so that you will have an opportunity to enter into God's place of rest Heaven. The people were contentious against Moses and Aaron. Time and time again they complained and confronted Moses. Miriam has died, they are in the wilderness with no water, and they still blame Moses and Aaron. They left the people went and prostrated themselves in the Tabernacle. There, God spoke to Moses. God told Moses to take his rod go to the people and speak to the rock and water will come. Moses gathered the people but instead of speaking to the rock, he struck it twice in disobedience to God's instruction. Because of this disobedience, Moses and Aaron were denied entry into the Promise Land. (1.): Following God's plan will not always make your life easy. (2.): People will blame you when things doesn't go smoothly. (3.): Keep yourself in good standings with God. Pray and seek his guidance. (4.): God holds us accountable for the things He has told us to do. (5.): Our disobedience will bring about the wrath of God. Deuteronomy tells us that God was so angry with Moses that He was denied entry into the Promise land and that his assistant, Joshua, would lead the people in. Not following God will have grave consequences.

Taking God Seriously is something we all must do. If we have a desire for Eternal Life, we must take God seriously.

This has been a great study and I pray that we all Take Seriously what God has done and is doing. My prayer is for God to continue to bless this ministry as we strive to share the Good News of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior?

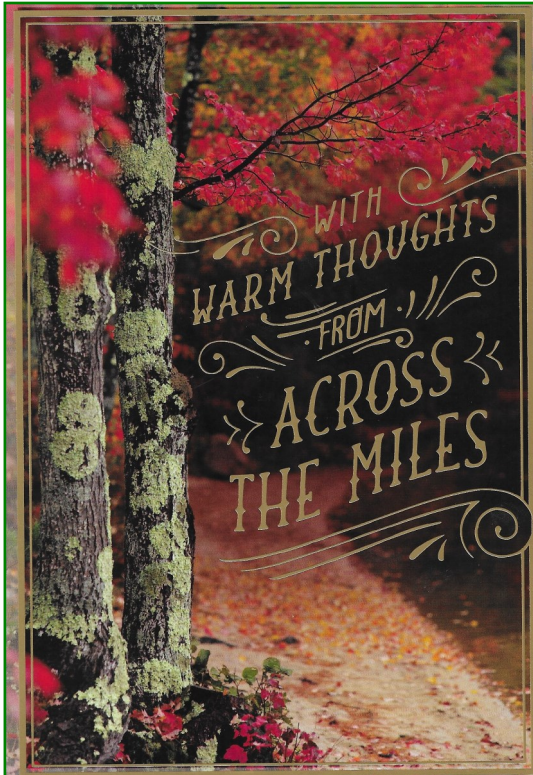

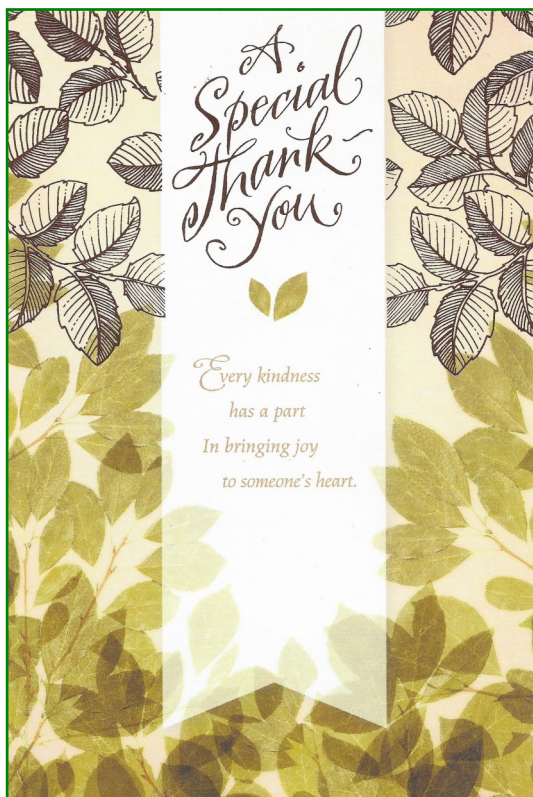

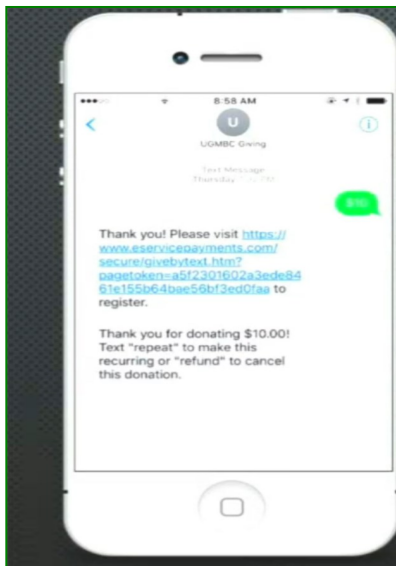
