

I Cor. 12:1, 28 – Now concerning spiritual gifts ... And God have set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers ...

Adult Sunday School Teachers

Elder Connie Dinkins, Brother Michael White, and Minister Arie Freeman, Jr.

For the month of February, we were in the Winter Quarter which consists of three units; Unit I: Blessing of a Saviour, Unit II: Blessing of the Gospel; and Unit 3: Blessing of Grace in Christ. We were in the last unit, Unit III, Blessing of the Gospel. For February, Elder Connie Dinkins and Minister Arie Freeman facilitated the lessons. This entire quarter, we will be studying from the theme: God's Great Blessings.

Unit 3: Blessing of Grace in Christ:

In this unit we will see firsthand the blessings of the Amazing Grace that God has provided for us through Jesus Christ. The people who are willing and faithful to serve Him. That blessing includes belonging to Christ, being assured of comfort and peace and in the midst of our struggles we are never alone. God has done great things and he will continue as we trust and obey Him. The lessons of Unit 3 were Blessing amid Trials; Blessing of God's Comfort, Blessing of Godliness; and lastly Blessing of Spiritual Fruits.

Lesson 1: Blessing amid Trials: As we begin this lesson, James starts with two words: Faith and Endurance. We must have faith in the midst of our trials and sufferings. He also tells us when our faith has been tested it is a chance for our endurance to grow. He also says that the trying of our faith worketh patience. As we go through these difficulties, we must seek God's wisdom to help us. Pt.1: We have to learn that our afflictions can produce something good in us, transparent before God. It can strengthen our faith and help us to trust God more. Pt.2: Stay vigilant in our prayers for wisdom, knowledge, and understanding then you can Count it all Joy. Even though times get rough we must persevere. God has promised a Crown of Life. We will see it in eternity. We have been changed by the power of Christ and given a new life. Pt.3: That Crown is promised to those who trust and Love God. Jesus said, "If you love me, keep my commandments". Pt.4: It is our love for God that enables us to endure whatever God allows in our lives. God has a perfect gift for us. Jesus is the source of that gift. All good things can be traced back to God. He always wants what's best for us. Share the message of God. We have been given another chance; we should freely reconcile with others. Pt.5: Do not be deceived, Good and Perfect gifts come from above where God reigns. The promise is from God and He will never go back on His word.

Lesson 2: Blessing of God's Comfort: In this lesson we examined the outlines the Value of Comfort and the Value of prayer. Comfort and Prayer are essential parts of life. God is called the Father of mercies and of all comfort. It is God who gives comfort personally as we go through the trials and tribulations of Life. God comforts us so we can bring comfort to others. We are partakers in the suffering of Christ and because of this God has promised us strength and rest from our labor. Pt.1: None of us likes suffering, however there can be a greater meaning behind the suffering. Pt.2: We must never think that trouble and trials are accidents. As believers we know that God is always in control, and we must trust Him. Prayer is of great value. We are told that man ought to always pray because of the Power of Prayer. The trials we go through can extract a heavy burden and

that's where prayer comes in. God knows what we go through and all the circumstances and through prayer we know that the God we serve can deliver us. Pt.3: Never underestimate God's use of our prayers in our deliverance.

Pt.4: We will learn that God often uses suffering to cause us to lean and depend on Him more.

Pt.1: People should be able to see Jesus in us by our actions. In Jesus, we have nothing to complain about. He has and will provide for us. Because of this divine power we have been tasked to add essential ingredients to our lives. As disciples we are to continually grow. We grow by increasing in faith, virtue, knowledge, and patience. Pt.2: God has given us His nature and we must utilize all that he has given us. As we grow in Christ we can begin to live productive godly lives. This is where endurance and perseverance comes in. We will have some good days and some bad days, but we cannot quit and give up. We must be diligent, steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord. Pt.3: We can be confident that God will strengthen us for the task ahead.

Lesson 4: Blessing of Spiritual Fruits: In this lesson Paul begins by telling of the works of the flesh. Adultery, fornication, wrath, and uncleanness are fleshly. The flesh will crave these desires and we will not inherit the kingdom of God. As true believers we are to stand fast in the liberty Christ has given them. We are not the judge. Don't criticize others. It's all up to God. People will point out our sins. Fruit of the spirit comes from the Holy Spirit. We are to live and walk in the spirit. All the fruit are God-given and we should not want what others have. Pt.1: The freedom we have in Jesus can help us combat our fight with sin. Pt.2: Our flesh has been crucified and we now live by faith in Jesus. Jesus changed all of that with his death on the Cross. Pt.3: We should model the attributes of God in our daily lives. We have a responsibility to help others. When others slip and fall we have a responsibility to restore others. We are to share in the suffering and burdens of others. Never think too highly of yourself. Pt.4: Whatever you do, do it in Love, for love overcomes obstacles and breaks barriers. We must always act in humility and show compassion. We must be supportive of one another. Pt.5: Never stop doing good. For in due season, we shall reap a good harvest. Let us do good to all men.

In March we will begin the Spring Quarter discussing the theme: "Jesus Pleases His Father." The Units include Unit I. By His Works; Unit II. By His Sacrifice and Unit III: By His Teachings.





Early Spring?

It's March already! Since the year is speeding by, we need to catch up financially. What things should we be doing now:

- a. If you haven't already, get a copy of your credit report and READ IT!

 Check all the open accounts to be sure they're ones you opened. Check the balances as well. If
 there are any accounts that show late or missed payments, address these. Are there a few
 accounts with low balances you could pay off? NOTE: If these are major credit cards, don't close
 them. Just pay the balance and charge something at least once a year to keep them active.
- b. File your income taxes. There is an increase in tax fraud. If you file as quickly as possible, thieves don't have a chance to steal your refund.
- c. If you are not tithing, start! Start with 1% of your income, next month/payday, increase to 3%, increase each payday until you reach at least 10%. As you increase your tithing, make adjustments in other spending.
- d. Schedule a monthly transfer from your checking account to your savings account. This is the perfect solution if you look at your budget and know how much you can save. Just set it and forget it.
- e. Review your auto, home, health insurance, cell phone, and cable bills and see if you can save money by switching.
- f. If after checking everything, there is still a shortfall, consider getting a part-time job for a short time to help you pay off those outstanding debts that break your budget.






