Get Back to Work

Haggai 1; 2:4

We hate it when our devices are buffering. That's when the little circle thing is spinning around and around while we're waiting on our device to reconnect to the worldwide web. The prophet Haggai ministered while the Jews were sort of buffering. They were allowed to leave exile in Babylon and return to Jerusalem to rebuild the Lord's Temple. When Haggai arrived in Jerusalem, however, the Jews had stopped working on the Temple for years. Their work on the Lord's house was buffering. Haggai and Zechariah preached to persuade the inhabitants of Jerusalem to stop buffering and resume working on rebuilding the Lord's Temple. They got back to work. Let me give you three reasons why.



1. The work resumed because the people adjusted their priorities. (1:3, 12)

The Jews' priorities were out of order. The Lord asked them why they were living in luxurious houses while God's house lay in ruins. If they adjusted their priorities by pushing rebuilding the Lord's Temple up higher on their list of things they had going on, God would be pleased and honored (1:7-8). They adjusted their priorities to reflect what would please and honor the Lord (1:12). Adjust your priorities! Make building God's house a high priority in your life.

2. The work resumed because the people accepted the prophet and his exhortation. (1:12)

The Jews accepted Haggai and Zechariah for who they were—prophets of the Lord. Your perception of a prophet impacts what you can receive from that prophet. The Jews received the prophets and the exhortations they declared.

It's a good thing they did. What God had to say through the prophet Haggai was powerful. In Haggai chapter 1, the Word of the Lord addressed the past and the present. In chapter 2, however, there is focus on the future (2:4-9). The Lord, through His prophet, encouraged His people to be strong (2:4). He assured them His Spirit was among them (2:5), and that there was a future glory awaiting the temple (2:9).

God's prophet shared God's Word. The people accepted it as such, and it empowered them to get back to work. Please receive this: be strong! Allow His Spirit to give you power for the role you play in the Lord's Temple. Let's trust God for a future glory at Union Grove that will be greater than all past glory!



3. The work resumed because the people were animated by God. (1:14)

Everyone was sparked with enthusiasm. They were fired up, awakened, animated. God set His people on fire, and they resumed working on His Temple. Some folks are unable to be animated. Why? Because stuff in their hearts like carnality, worldliness, and negative self-talk can act as a fire retardant.

But there are some things that make you flammable, “animatable”. Conviction of sin, repentance, humility, and brokenness are excellent realities for starting fires in our hearts.

God sparked something inside of them! May the Lord set your heart on fire today! May everyone already on fire at Union Grove continue to be steadfast and unmovable in the work of the Lord. Be sure to guard your fire with meditation, prayer, time in solitude, and stay clear of people who are like fire extinguishers.

For those among us who have disconnected from serving in ministry, my prayer is that you get back to work. Give God all of you. Exchange your buffering for the Lord’s blessing. Adjust your priorities. Accept the prophet and the exhortation the Lord has given me for our Grove Zone family. And may the Lord set you on fire like never before. Be encouraged and enjoy the journey!

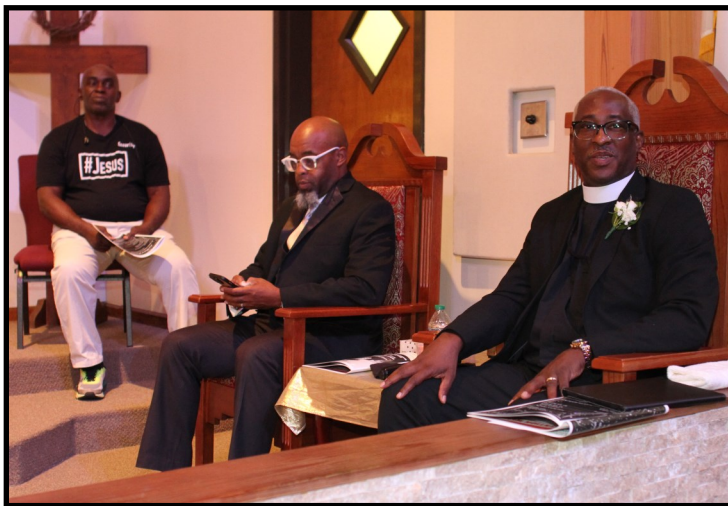

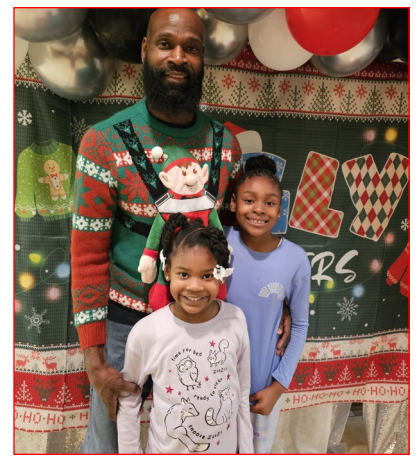

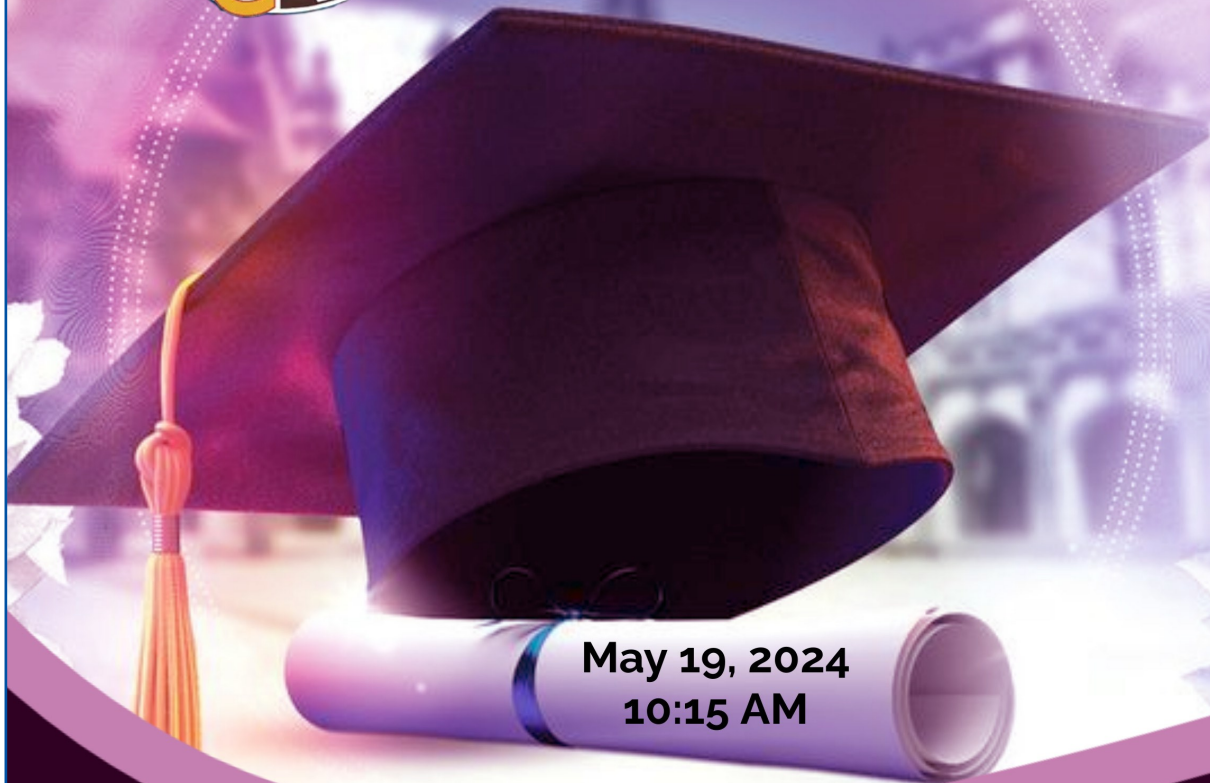

Happy New Year!!!

Wow! It's 2024! Since we've been studying the Old Testament, let's look at a scripture that will hopefully inspire us to do better in 2024. Isaiah 41:10 ***Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.***

How does this scripture help us with our finances? Whatever mistakes we made or did not make in 2023, is done. Be assured that God is still with us to help us fix our finances as well as our spiritual lives. That debt we added in 2023, let's tackle it this year so we will have a prosperous new year.

- a. Get a copy of your credit report from **one** of the credit reporting agencies. Do a thorough review. Go to **Annualcreditreport.com**. This is the free one with no strings attached. The one required by the government. Next quarter get a copy from one of the others.
- b. MAKE NO NEW DEBT!**
- c. Apply the **debt stacking** method to all your debt, i.e., pay the smallest balance off first (only paying the minimum on other bills), once it's paid off, roll that payment to the next lowest balance, until all bills are paid off. **NOTE: DO NOT CLOSE MAJOR CREDIT CARDS.** Put them in the drawer to save for travel.
- d. If you're like me, you've gotten quite a few offers to transfer balances from high interest cards to "**zero interest rate**" cards for a limited time. These can be helpful if you are disciplined. By **disciplined** I mean taking the high interest card out of your wallet, pay the zero-interest card off in the time they state, otherwise, you will end up paying all interest accrued from the first day.
- e. If you have high balances on "high interest" cards, consider refinancing your home to consolidate your debt. Again, you must be **disciplined** so you don't get back into debt or end up in worse shape.
- f. Take that **extra money** you got in your Social Security, Cost of Living, gifts, or other raise, and apply it directly to your debt.
- g. Set up your **budget** and stick to it.

Now let's reduce our other expenses.

- a. Use a list when grocery shopping. Use coupons. Stay away from the snack aisle unless you are getting snacks for school students.
- b. Check your credit card statements regularly to insure there are no fraudulent charges. Also, there may be some recurring charges you weren't aware of.
- c. Shop around for your internet, cable, and phone bills. Compare prices and make the best deal for you at this moment. If you aren't watching those premium channels, cancel them.



Isaiah 40:31 ESV /

But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

As we come into this new year what will be our desires? Will it be more money, a new car or a bigger house? To many of us, we want a clean slate and a fresh start. We want to hopefully be able to forget the problems we had in the previous years. Sometimes, it may seem that we are all alone and no one cares, and it's taking us **forever** to obtain what we want. If you go into that church called the Grove Zone, you'll meet some parishioners that know differently.

You might even hear the choir sing that popular song by Dottie People." *He's An On Time God.*"

If we choose to trust God instead of panicking, we must also need to remember these two concepts: one, God is never in a hurry. and two, God is never late. God's timing is always perfect. If we should think that God is late think about one particular miracle demonstrated by Jesus. We all should remember the story of Lazarus with his sisters Mary and Martha. The sister desired healing from Jesus who was only 5 miles away. After their brother's death the sister told Jesus Lazarus would have survived if He had come in time. Because it took Jesus 3 days to travel those 5 miles, Lazarus died. As we know, Jesus was not there to heal Lazarus, but to raise him from the dead!

Sometimes, God will let a situation get so bad that only a miracle performed by Him will increase our faith. If we hold on, pray to Him, keep believing we are getting ready for a miracle! God knows what He will do for our life tomorrow, next month, next year and in the next decade. ***We must remember His plan for us is the right plan for us.***

We must remember God's timing is always perfect!

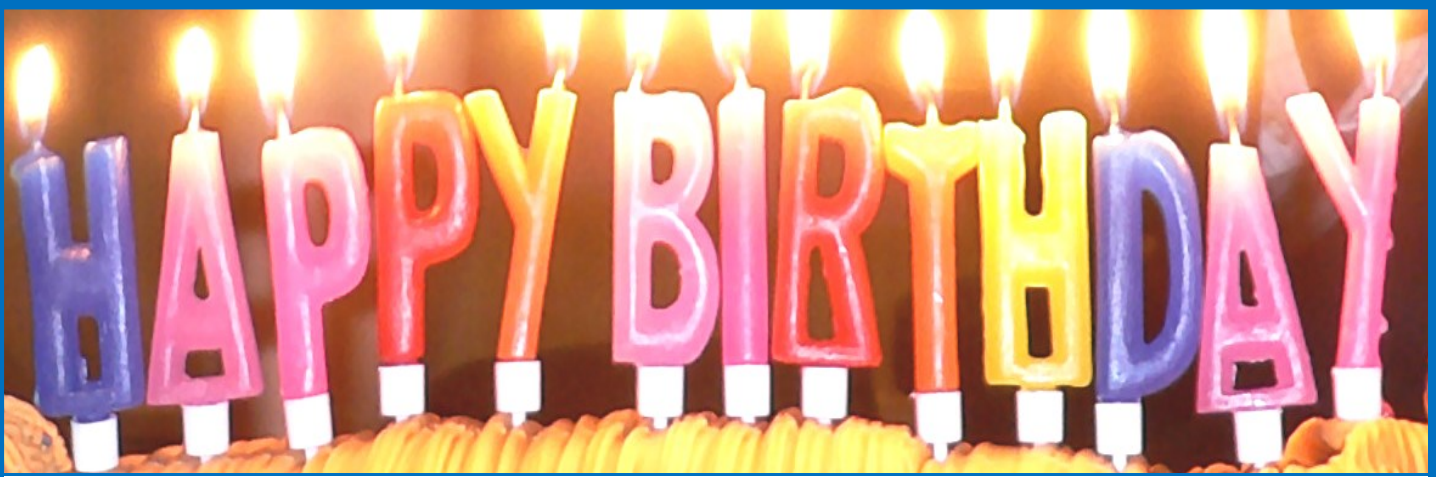

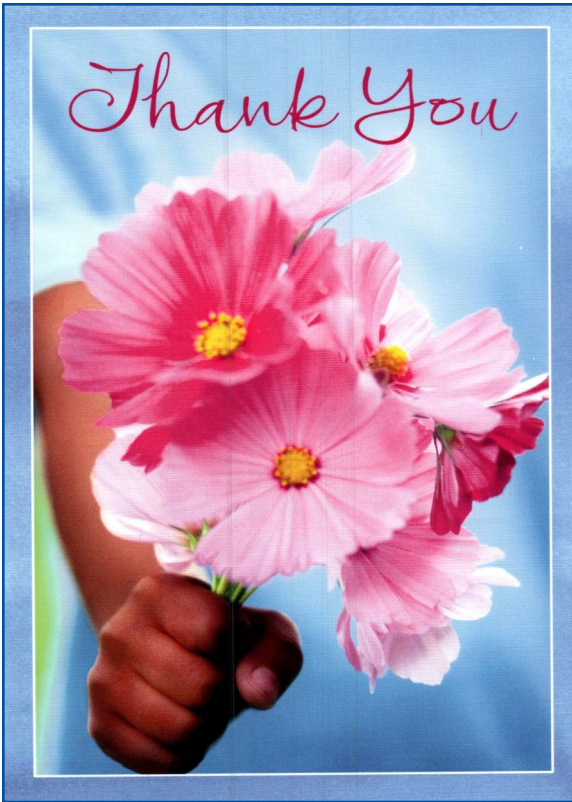


